What You Can Do at Home:

Talk with your child about clothes. Examine the fabrics together and discuss how the clothes were made. Look at the labels to find out where the clothes were made and identify the fabric. Look at pictures from the past and note how the clothing differs from clothing today. Teach your child to stitch. Use a large plastic needle and yarn; make stitches on burlap or felt. When you shop for clothes, help your child notice how clothes are organized in the store and offer a simple explanation of how you compare prices. Have fun!
